in the area of behavioral economics. The candidate must have completed a PhD degree in economics or a related field (or should be close to completion by the start date) and possess a strong interest in experimental and behavioral economics. Proficiency in oral and written English is required. The position should be filled from October 2016 on or shortly thereafter.

A major area of current research at the department are projects that seek to better understand the the role of social norms, fairness, justice, as well as compliance costs in shaping both income and consumption tax compliance behaviors, with experimental and empirical tools. Furthermore, there are ongoing research projects that aim to understand the role of institutional design in labor markets. Collaboration in ongoing research projects is expected, but there will also be the opportunities for independent research.

We are offering a (postdoctoral) fellowship for initially one year with the possibility to extend the scholarship by another year upon positive evaluation. The research group offers a lively research environment, financial support for attending conferences, an office and access to all university facilities, including the Laboratory of Experimental Research (LERN). In order to increase the proportion of female researchers, applications from female scientists are particularly encouraged. Preference will be given to disabled persons with the same qualification.
