Postdoctoral Fellowship in Experimental and Behavioral Economics

(1 + 1 year)

The Chair of Economic Theory at FAU Erlangen-Nuremberg offers a Postdoctoral Fellowship as of October 1, 2019 (or later). The Chair focuses on research in experimental and behavioral economics as well as market design.

The position is non-tenured and is targeted at early PhD graduates to develop their research output before moving on to tenure track or tenured positions. The successful candidate will be encouraged to work on projects relating to "the influence of digitalization, tracking and monitoring on economic decision making" and "the influence of social norms and social networks on the formation of opinion and decisional biases".

Applicants should have a PhD degree (or close to completion) in economics or comparable subjects. The ideal candidate has experience in experimental or empirical research and has strong quantitative background. Candidates should have published in internationally recognized journals or have several papers with high publication potential. Proficiency in English is required and German would be an asset.

Fields of responsibility may include participation in ongoing research and teaching, as well as participation in activities of one of the Chair's projects. **The initial appointment is one year and can be extended for an additional year (1+1 year).** Women are strongly encouraged to apply. Disabled applicants will be preferred when equally qualified.
