Postdoctoral Fellowship in Experimental and Behavioural Economics (1 + 1 year)

The Chair of Economic Theory at FAU Erlangen-Nuremberg offers a Postdoctoral Fellowship starting in October 2020 (or later). The Chair focuses on research in experimental and behavioural economics as well as energy market design.

The position is non-tenured and is targeted at early PhD graduates to develop their own research profile before moving on to tenure track or tenured positions. Applications in fields related to behavioural and experimental economics are welcome, with a preference for candidates who specialise in a) the influence of digitalisation, tracking and monitoring on economic decision making, b) social learning in networks, or c) social identity.

Applicants should have a PhD degree (or close to completion) in economics or comparable subjects. The ideal candidate has experience in experimental or empirical research and has strong quantitative background. Candidates should have published in internationally recognised journals or have several papers with high publication potential. Proficiency in English is required, and German would be an asset.

Fields of responsibility may include participation in ongoing research and teaching, as well as engage in activities of one of the Chair's projects. **The initial appointment is one year and can be extended for an additional year (1+1 year).** Women are strongly encouraged to apply.
